Great news! I am now a volunteer Ambassador for the Military Women's Memorial, (MWM) Arlington, VA. This is the only memorial that honors the service of Military Women from all branches of service. The mission of the Memorial is to continue to support H.E.R.

- H - HONOR – service and sacrifice
- E - EDUCATE and EMPOWER—current and future generations
- R - REMEMBER – those who have paved the way

This is a great honor for me. I have always been a supporter of the Memorial. In fact, when I retired from the Army, my retirement reception was there and when I was inducted into the Army Women's Foundation-Hall of Fame it was done at MWM.

Now that I am an Ambassador for MWM, I would like to educate, empower, and get military women register in the Memorial. **My goal is to get 98 military women, all ranks, from all branches of service registered by Sept 16, 2021.**

Why Sept 2021? Because we lost Ms. Deloris L. Ruddock, a member of the 6888th Central Postal Directory Battalion on March 27, 2021. Ms. Ruddock would have been 98 on Sept 16th. She and 854 Black Women were assigned to the all-BLACK Female Postal Unit during World War 11. I would like to honor their service and sacrifice, educate today's and future generation about the unit, and remind them, that the ALL BLACK FEMALE UNIT-6888TH also guarantee our FREEDOM!



So, help me get 98 military women register into the Memorial, so their service and sacrifice will always be remembered. If you are not a member, fill out the form.
